

**Right of Inurnment
At the Piedmont Episcopal Church Columbarium**

THIS RIGHT OF INURNMENT, Made and entered into on _____
by and between Piedmont Episcopal Church hereinafter referred to as the "Church" and
_____. hereinafter referred to as the "Purchaser".

WHEREAS, the Church has installed a columbarium known as the Piedmont Episcopal Church Columbarium for the inurnment of the cremated remains of members of the Church and their families and

WHEREAS, the Church has established a policy governing the eligibility for and use of the Columbarium and the Purchaser, who has received a copy of the policy and understands the contents thereof and agrees to abide by it, the said policy attached to this agreement is incorporated as if fully set out herein. The Purchaser agrees to future changes in said policies that may be made by the Church.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of \$500 (for two canisters) or \$300 (for one canister) paid to the Church by Purchaser, the parties covenant and agree with the other as follows:

1. The Church agrees to provide to Purchaser a niche in the columbarium for the cremated remains of one or two persons, to provide a standard urn for each person, to have the brass nameplate inscribed with the name, birth and death years of each person and to provide maintenance.
2. The Purchaser is to provide the information indicated below for the person(s) whose cremated remains will be inurned in the columbarium: (PLEASE PRINT)

3. Piedmont Episcopal Church shall retain title to said property and grants hereby to the Purchaser the right to the use of the columbarium in accordance with the policies referred to above.
4. Purchaser warrants a property right in and to the mortal remains of the person(s) anticipated to be inurned and further warrants authority to execute this agreement. The Church assumes no responsibility to inquire further into the authority of the person executing this contract.
5. Full authority is given Piedmont Episcopal Church, to move or relocate niches with cremains, if, for any reason the Columbarium needs be relocated. If this is needed, it will be completed at the expense of the Church.
